City Recorder Dallas Brockett provided the upcoming agenda items.

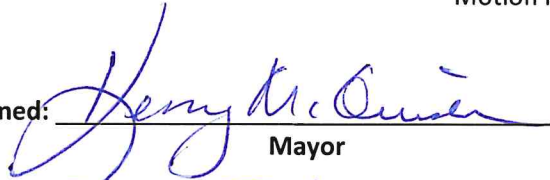
